

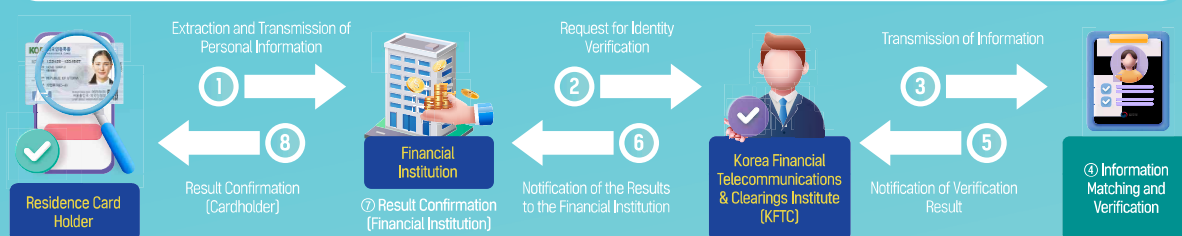

Foreign Registration Card Verification Service Expanded to the Non-Banking Sector

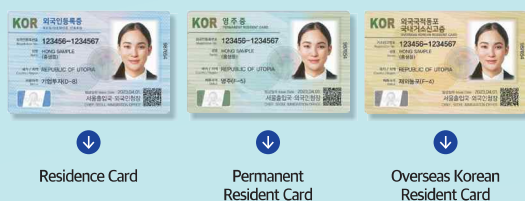
Easy and Convenient Financial Services in the Non-Banking Sector Are Now Accessible to Registered Foreign Residents

The Ministry of Justice has expanded the Foreign Registration Card Verification Service to include non-bank financial institutions, allowing registered foreign nationals to verify their identity at service counters and through mobile apps. The service checks personal information and facial images from Residence Cards—including Permanent Resident and Overseas Korean Residence Cards—against the Ministry of Justice's database and provides real-time verification results. With this expansion, registered foreign residents can now complete identity verification at non-bank institutions using the same process available at banks.
