MOJ and Business Associations Hold Roundtable on Streamlined Entry Program for Foreign Business Travelers

Sharing Outcomes of Pilot Project and Gathering Feedback

The Ministry of Justice (MOJ, Minister JUNG Sung-ho) held a roundtable meeting on Monday, December 15, 2025 with foreign chambers of commerce in Korea and prominent business associations.

- ▷ (Participants) The Federation of Korean Industries, the Federation of Middle Market Enterprises of Korea, the Korea Enterprises Federation, the Korea International Trade Association, Korea Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Korea Federation of SMEs, Korea Foreign Company Association, and chambers of commerce in Korea representing the US, Canada, France, Australia, Europe, India, China, Japan, and Germany.

The meeting was convened to share the results and hear feedback of the pilot operation of priority immigration lanes for foreign business travelers, which has been in place since August 31.

Arnold Lee of the Australia Chamber of Commerce who attended the meeting said, “Thank you for all the contribution Ministry of justice makes, if the Streamlined entry program launch officially following pilot operation, Australia Chamber of Commerce would be pleased to participate. ”

MOJ will review the opinions expressed by participants and reflect them in future operational plans, with the aim of supporting the global network development for domestic companies and promoting the active engagement and investment

of foreign businesspersons in Korea.

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Annex	Key Points Streamlined Entry Program for Foreign Business Travelers
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- Priority Immigration Lanes for Foreign Business Travelers
 - Business Associations* authorized to make recommendations submit an official note to the Incheon Airport Immigration Office of the individuals selected from companies within their allocated quota
 - The Federation of Korean Industries, the Federation of Middle Market Enterprises of Korea, the Korea Enterprises Federation, the Korea International Trade Association, the American Chamber of Commerce in Korea, and the European Chamber of Commerce in Korea
 - Individuals will be registered eligible to use the priority (designated) immigration lanes
 - Family members and accompanying travelers will also be eligible to use the priority immigration lanes
- Regarding Operation
 - Pilot operation from August 31 to December 31, 2025 at Incheon International Airport
 - After the pilot, full-scale implementation and expansion to additional airports will be considered based on collected feedback
